Wayfinding Sign Concepts Further Refined

The City is pursuing a wayfinding signage program that will help guide motorists and pedestrians to popular destinations within Southlake. The Wayfinding Signage Committee and staff have been working with [RSM Design](#) to create a wayfinding sign that fits the character and urban design of Southlake. The next step for the committee is to view a full-scale mock-up of the sign in various locations throughout the city so a design recommendation (color, size, etc.) can be finalized. All of the committee's meetings have been open to the public, but the sign designs will go through the SPIN meeting process, the Planning & Zoning Commission and City Council for additional public input over the course of the next two months.

First Youth Planning Focus Group Complete

Students to Present Recommendations to City Council

The City of Southlake has added a significant component to the comprehensive plan: youth input. During the month of October, city staff worked with a focus group of fifteen students at Carroll Senior High School to generate sixteen recommendations—largely covering land use and mobility—that will be presented to City

Council at their meeting on November 17, 2009 at 5:30PM. All recommendations made by various youth focus groups throughout the next two school years will be part of a special “Youth Plan” and will be formally considered by the Southlake 2030 committees for inclusion in the plan elements (i.e. Land Use Plan, Mobility Plan, Sustainability Plan, etc.).
