A recording of this meeting will be made and will be available to the public in accordance with the Open Meetings Act.



2. SPIN2020-07 – An applicant is proposing a full-service hotel with restaurant (previously referred to as "Southwest Meadows") on approximately six (6) acres located at 1901 W. Kirkwood Blvd. within SPIN Neighborhood #1.
3. SPIN2020-09 – An applicant is proposing a permanent variance to the Southlake City Code (Chapter 11, Article III – Noise Nuisances) to allow for golf course maintenance to occur at 6:00 AM at Timarron Country Club, generally located south of E. Continental Blvd., east of Bent Creek Dr., north of State Hwy 26, and west of Byron Nelson Pkwy. within SPIN Neighborhood #9.
