A recording of this meeting will be made and will be available to the public in accordance with the Open Meetings Act.



SPIN2020-19 – An applicant is proposing a zoning change and site plan/concept plan for an approximately 80,000 square foot light industrial/corporate office building as well as three (3) mixed use commercial/office buildings totaling approximately 59,000 square feet for GMI located at 2450 Crooked Lane within SPIN Neighborhood #8.
3. SPIN2020-20 – An applicant is proposing a zoning change and development plan to develop an 8-lot single-family residential subdivision on approximately 13.2 acres located at 2970 Burney Lane and 3185 Southlake Park Dr. within SPIN Neighborhood #2.
4. SPIN2020-21 – An applicant (Carroll Independent School District) is proposing variance to the Lighting Ordinance No. 693, as amended, to replace the existing tennis court lights at Carroll Senior High School located 1501 W. Southlake Blvd. within SPIN Neighborhood #10.
