Request for Deferred Disposition:

A 90-day probation, pay full fine plus \$25 special expense fee.

You may request Deferred Disposition by mail if all of the following are true:

- ✓ You are at least 18 years of age & not a high school student.
- ✓ You do not have a Commercial Driver's License currently or at the time of offense.
- ✓ You have *not* been cited for a moving violation during the past 6 months in the State of Texas.
- ✓ You are not currently participating in a Deferred Disposition in *any* court.
- ✓ Your current citation cites no more than one moving violation.
- ✓ You are not charged with speeding in excess of 24 mph over the limit, nor a construction zone violation.

Request By Mail-Provide the following two (2) items to Municipal Court:

1. A completed Request Form. Sign and submit the Request Form below.
2. Payment: Fines (fees) for each violation are listed on the [Court website](#). You may also call the Court for current fine amounts.
