Roof Replacement - What You Need to Know

The International Residential Code requires a building permit for roof replacement. Contractors performing such work must register with the City which involves the submittal of a registration form and payment of the \$105.00 registration fee. The building permit application must be submitted along with the \$50.00 permit fee. Once processed, the contractor is given a laminated permit card to be posted at the project site in plain view so that anyone driving by knows the job has an active permit.

Upon completion of the work, the contractor shall schedule a final inspection. The building inspector will check the roof from the ground for compliance and either approve or disapprove the work performed. The inspector will check the attic areas for appliance vents that may have been dislodged or altered during construction. This courtesy inspection requires that the homeowner/occupant is present to allow access for the inspector and as such, the contractor is responsible to coordinate specific times to make this feasible.

When choosing a contractor, homeowners should check references as well as the Better Business Bureau (BBB) to help in their decision. Carefully examine work history for roofers that are out of the area and especially out of state. Most importantly, be suspicious of contractors who demand payment up front as part of the transaction. Doing your homework before signing a contract can eliminate the grief that comes from being a victim of fraud.
