

COVID-19 RESPONSE TARRANT COUNTY STAY-AT-HOME ORDER

In response to the COVID-19 outbreak, Tarrant County Judge B. Glen Whitley issued an executive order requiring all residents of Tarrant County to stay-at-home until April 7, 2020, with exceptions for essential businesses and services, essential travel, engaging in outdoor activity or to care for family or pets in other households. The order was issued in an effort to promote health and prevent the spread of COVID-19.

Keep in mind, that all activities are to take place under social distancing requirements, keeping 6 feet or more distance in between people. This is a summary of the order. View the full order from Tarrant County at www.ProtectSouthlake.com.
