<p>Chapter II. City Council and Mayor Section 2.04. Qualifications Candidate. Each person who becomes a candidate for Mayor or Council member shall meet the following qualifications:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. be at least 21 years of age;</li> <li>2. be a citizen of the United States;</li> <li>3. be a qualified voter of the City;</li> <li>4. reside and have resided for at least twelve (12) months preceding the election within the corporate limits of the City;</li> <li>5. no candidate may file for more than one office or position number per election;</li> <li>6. no employee of the City shall continue in such position after becoming a candidate for an elective office.</li> </ol>	<p>May 6, 2023 Election February 17, 2023 by 5:00 PM</p>	
<p><i>Candidates are strongly encouraged to obtain a candidate packet. Candidate forms are available on the <a href="#">Secretary of State website</a>, but the full Candidate Packet (recommended) is obtained from the City Secretary.</i></p> <p><i>***The filing period begins on the 108<sup>th</sup> day prior to the election date and ends on the 78<sup>th</sup> day at 5 p.m. prior to the election date.</i></p>
